We received a brief notice of the recent Episcopal labors of Rt. Rev. Dr. Brutè. This venerable prelate in his Cathedral Church of Vincennes, assisted by Rev. Mr. La Lumière, promoted to the order of Subdeacon Mr. Matthew Ruff on the 4th April, and to that of Deacon, on the 10th of the same month.

On Easter day, he admitted to the Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist, 55 first communicants and on the Octave Sunday, five or six more. Among these young persons, were some, eighteen or twenty years of age.

On Low Sunday, the Bishop Confirmed 85 of his flock. Of these 45 were boys. This we believe is his first ordination, as well as his first confirmation. We rejoice in these evidences of a zeal, fruitful in good works: and we rejoice the more, because its holy influence is exercised upon the young, strengthening them in the faith of their fathers;—& kindling in their breasts the flame of piety which we hope will burn brightly to the end.
