REV. FATHER CHASSE.

At 2:40 o'clock this morning, Rev. J. B. Chasse, chaplain of St. Mary's, died at the institution of heart disease, after an illness of five weeks. He had been somewhat unwell for two years past. The deceased came to this city about eleven years ago, from New Albany, and served for five years as pastor of St. Joseph's Church. He was then appointed chaplain at St. Mary's, and filled the position until the hour of his death. Father Chasse was born in Brittany, France, January sixth, 1815. He was early educated in the Roman church, and was a faithful apostle of the pope all his life. The funeral will take place on Wednesday, at 10 o'clock A. M., and will be attended by all the priesthood of the diocese, including Fort Wayne and Cincinnati.
