## Rev. Robert Gorman dies at the age of 58

Archishop Schulte will offer a Solemn Pontifical Funeral Mass for Father Robert E. Gorman, Ph.D., professor of history at St. Mary-ofthe-Woods College and Archdiocesan historian and acchivist, at 11 a.m. Monday, May 11, in the Church of the Immaculate Conception at St. Mary-ofthe-Woods.

Father Gorman, 38, died on Thursday morning, May 7, (Officers of the Funeral Mass were not available at the Criterion's press lime.) Burial will take place in the community cemelery of the Sisters of Providence, who conduct M. Mary-of-the-Woods College.

A native of Evansville, Pather Gorman was ordained in 1930 tollowing studies at St. Meinrad Seminary, He served as assistant pastor of Assumption parish, Evansville, and St. Ann's parish, Terre Haute, before starting graduate studies at the Cathoric University of America in 1935.

He received a doctor of philoso-

phy degree there in 1938. The following year he joined the faculty of St. Mary-of-the-Woods College. At the time of death, he
